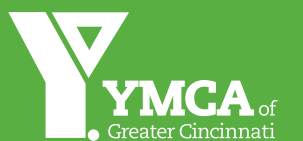
Located in the heart of Loveland, we will be providing the perfect surrounding for the children to appreciate nature, build skills, memories and friendships that will last a lifetime!

COUNSELOR-IN-TRAINING PROGRAM

COUNSELOR IN TRAINING (CIT): Teens who are hoping to be future camp staff have the opportunity to get advanced training. The CIT program helps teens begin to develop the values, knowledge, skills and experience needed to be qualified and dedicated Camp Loveland staff members in the future. It is also a perfect way for teens to serve camp and grow. Each week, CITs work with counselors and receive supportive supervision and evaluation. Those interested must complete both a camper and a CIT application. Strong CITs are recommended to return for further development or are given a referral to be on staff the following summer as a Junior Counselor. Participation in the CITs does not guarantee a staff position in the future, but it is favorable.
