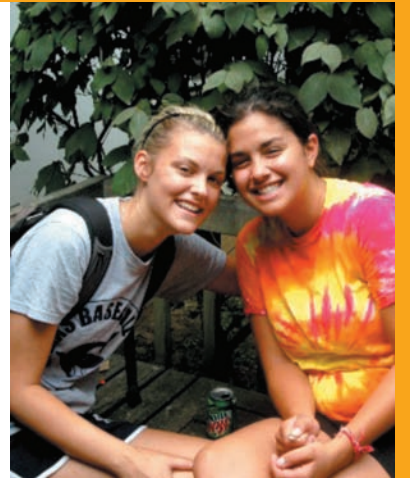
ACA ACCREDITED SUMMER DAY CAMP: Offering fun in the sun. We accept Hamilton County vouchers.
