

Colerain Lacrosse Club (Clippard Family YMCA)
2009 Code of Conduct Agreement
for Players and Parents

Participation in the Colerain Lacrosse Club is a privilege, not a right. Students participating in the Colerain Lacrosse Club not only represent the Colerain Lacrosse Club, but the Clippard Family YMCA, the community and parents that support them. Student-Athletes should conduct themselves with PRIDE, HONOR, and DISCIPLINE at all times; on and off the field. When the student-athlete puts on the Colerain Lacrosse Club jersey or spirit wear, they should wear them with pride.

Being a Colerain Lacrosse Club player carries with it the additional responsibility of maintaining the highest personal and ethical conduct. Each player shall abide by the US Lacrosse Code of Conduct and the Colerain Lacrosse Club (Clippard Family YMCA) Player Handbook and the Code of Conduct outlined in the handbook. Student-Athletes shall conduct themselves both in and out of school in a manner that reflects good citizenship. Any behavior that results in dishonor to the player, the team, the Club, the YMCA, the community or their family will not be tolerated. Acts of unacceptable conduct include, but are not limited to, theft, vandalism, disrespect, and fighting. Colerain Lacrosse Club players shall not use or have in their possession, in any form, alcohol, tobacco, drugs or drug paraphernalia, in or out of season, at any time or at any place. A Student-Athlete who aids or assists another in committing any of the above infractions shall be deemed equally responsible for the offense and shall receive the same consequence.

Any violation of the US Lacrosse Code of Conduct or the Colerain Lacrosse Club Code of Conduct will result in the following:

First Violation: After Practice Motivation

Second Violation: Loss of 1 quarter of playing time at next scheduled game.

Third Violation: Full game suspension for next scheduled game.

Fourth Violation: Recommended suspension for the remainder of the season.

Player and Parent(s) must meet with Club Administrators, Coaches and Clippard YMCA Administration for review. The decision of this review Board is final and may result in suspensions for the following season.

Violations may include but are not limited to:

- Disrespect to Coaches, Teammates, Officials, Club Administrators or YMCA Staff/Administrators.
- Missing practice due to an unexcused absence
- Unacceptable behavior as outlined in this Code of Conduct Agreement
- Unacceptable school behavior, resulting in ASA, or suspension.

These consequences will be in addition to any consequences applied by the OHSAA guidelines, and as reported by Officials of the game. For example; if the Officials state a suspension of game is warranted and this is a first violation, the player will ensue After Practice Motivation and the game suspension.

Colerain Lacrosse Club Student-Athlete Pledge:

As a Colerain Lacrosse Club Player, I agree to abide by the Colerain Lacrosse Club Handbook, the US Lacrosse Code of Conduct and this Agreement. I also understand the consequences if I am to break this agreement or the Codes of Conduct. To demonstrate my understanding, I pledge to:

- Support my teammates by setting an example and abstaining from alcohol, tobacco and drugs.
- Not cover up for a teammate by lying if this Code of Conduct is broken. I will hold my teammates responsible for their actions.
- Support my teammates by encouraging them and not putting them down, making fun of them or abusing them in any way.
- Respect my coaches at all times; during practice and games.
- Respect all Officials during, before and after games.
- Respect the opposing teams' players, Coaches and fans before, during and after games.
- HONOR and RESPECT the Game of Lacrosse!
